General Information:

Rules: USGA & IHSAA Rules and local course rules govern play.

Tees: The GIRLS will be playing the RED Tees & the BOYS will be playing the BLUE Tees.

Number of Players: 5 golfers with the lowest 4 scores counting for the team score.

Attire: Restrooms will be available. Appropriate golf attire will be worn (slacks or golf shorts and a collared shirt, no cut-offs, blue jeans or denim will be allowed). Players are encouraged to arrive ready.

Awards: Awards presentation after all scores are recorded.

Post Tournament Meal: Lunch will be provided to all golfers, coaches, and scoring markers after the round. Players and coaches will have a ticket that can be turned in at any point during the event for their meal.

USGA and IHSAA Rules Apply

State Tournament Qualifying Information:

- 1) Tournament Tees: Girls = Red Tees, Boys = Blue Tees.
- 2) Number of Players: 5 golfers with the lowest 4 scores counting for the team score.
- 3) Top 4 teams from District III qualify for State Tournament.
- 4) The number of individual qualifiers is based on the number of complete teams competing in the District. Tournament. If a tie exists between the final qualifying positions, both individuals will advance.

Tie Breaking Procedures:

Team: 1st - 4th Places

Teams that are tied will play one hole with 5 golfers and score the 4 lowest individual scores. The team with the lowest combined team score will be declared the winner. If the teams remain tied at the end of the first hole played during sudden-death play, the same procedure will be used for the remaining holes until the tie is broken.

Individual:

When a tie occurs for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place honors at the conclusion of tournament play, the tie shall be broken by a sudden-death playoff hole. In the event of a tie in both the team & medalist competition, the individual playoff will be played with the team playoff.

Tee Times And Pairings:

Tee Times and pairings will be made at the end of the season. The Boys will be teeing off 1st with the 1's going out first to the fives and the Girls going out after in the same order.

Range Balls:

Each team will be provided range balls on the day of the event.

Local Course Rules:

- 1) Water hazards are to be played as marked with either yellow or red stakes.
- 2) White Stakes are out of bounds.
- 3) Overhead Wires – Must Re-Tee, No Penalty.
- 4) Rules Committee – John Lewis & Jacob Kimball – Centennial G.C Professional.

Etiquette:

Please remind your team that we are *guests* of the Centennial Golf Course - language and behavior need to be carefully tempered.

Please replace all divots, fix ball marks and rake bunkers.

Metal spikes are not allowed.

Awards:

Plaque awarded to 1st place team. Medals awarded to team members of 1st & 2nd place. Medals awarded for individuals who place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd.
